SANSKRIT OLYMPIADS 2025 7 DECEMBER 2025

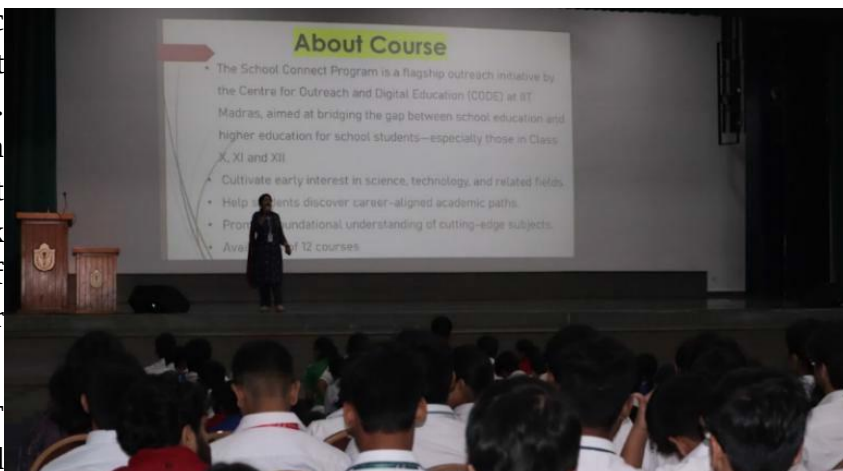

IIT MADRAS SCHOOL CONNECT–OCTOBER 2025 TO DECEMBER 2025

It gives us immense pride to share that Kumar Shubham (XI-A) and Satwik Singh (XI-A) of DPS RN Extension, Ghaziabad participated in the All India Asteroid Search Campaign (AIASC) 2025, an esteemed citizen science initiative organized by SPACE India in collaboration with the International Astronomical Search Collaboration (IASC) at Hardin Simmons University, Texas, USA.

The 2025 edition saw participation from around 90 schools across Delhi NCR for offline training and over 110 schools joined online. Our team, proudly named “SPACE RECON”, received exclusive access to astronomical images captured from professional observatories and utilized specialized software provided by the organizers to analyse celestial data. The students undertook asteroid identification tasks that contribute directly to NASA's and Jet Propulsion Laboratory's (JPL) Near-Earth Object (NEO) research databases.

This event not only provided our students with a hands-on experience in astronomy and data analysis but also nurtured scientific curiosity, collaborative learning, and real-world application of scientific methods.

- Mentor Teacher: Mrs. Anjali Johary and Ms. Purnima Batra

The AI Swachh Bin demonstrated an intelligent waste-segregation system that uses sensors and AI-based image recognition to categorize waste into biodegradable, recyclable, and hazardous types. This automated model promotes cleanliness, reduces manual sorting errors, and supports sustainable waste management. By integrating AI with civic responsibility, the project aligns strongly with the goals of a cleaner, smarter, and more efficient Swachh Bharat.

- Project-2: Carbon Dioxide Capsule for Preventing Fire in Circuit Boards by: Aryan Singh (VIII-E) and Aayushman Jha (VII-D)
- Mentor Teacher: Mr. Ashish Jain



This innovative project presented a heat-activated CO₂ capsule designed to prevent electrical fires in circuit boards. When excess heat or a short circuit occurs, the capsule bursts to release carbon dioxide, instantly suppressing sparks or flames. The model is cost-effective, compact, and practical for homes, schools, and industries. Due to its originality and real-world relevance, Project 2 was selected for the CBSE-National Science Exhibition Level Competition, bringing pride to the school.

The exhibition successfully highlighted how STEM education combined with artificial intelligence can create impactful, scalable solutions for national development, safety, and cleanliness.

The students had the opportunity to explore a wide range of professions through immersive role-playing activities. They could choose from roles such as delivery person, chef, judge, lawyer, police officer, firefighter, DJ, RJ, and farmer. Each role came with specific tasks that the children performed with guidance from the staff. For example, as delivery persons, students transported goods to different locations within KidZania. In the role of chefs, they prepared and served meals at a restaurant. As judges and lawyers, they presided over cases, defended clients, and delivered verdicts.

It provided students with valuable insights into various professions and life skills in an interactive and enjoyable manner.

VISIT TO INDIAN METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT LODHI ROAD, NEW DELHI 7 AUGUST 2025

An educational trip was organized for the students of Geography and Artificial Intelligence (AI) from classes XI and XII to the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD). The objective was to provide students with practical exposure to meteorology, hydrology, satellite technology, ozone observation, and radar systems—fields that directly intersect with both Geography and AI. The visit covered key divisions: the Hydrology Division, Ozone Observatory, SatMet (Satellite Meteorological) Division, and Radar Division. Hydrology Division The tour began at the **Hydrology Division**, where students learned about





the pivotal role of meteorology in hydrology, water resource management, and flood forecasting. The Hydromet Division disseminates crucial data and advice to government bodies, aiding in the management of river systems, flood warnings, and water resource planning. Students observed the extensive use of real-time rainfall data collection, weather stations, and digital tools like the Customised Rainfall Information System (CRIS). The practical demonstration included rainfall measurement techniques, water level monitoring, and the importance of accurate hydrological data for managing natural disasters and supporting agriculture

In the Ozone Observatory, students were introduced to India's network of ozone monitoring, which is essential for understanding atmospheric health and climate change. The IMD operates the National Ozone Centre, a designated regional center under the World Meteorological Organization. Students saw instruments like the Brewer and Dobson spectrometers for measuring the total ozone column and learned about the ozonesonde balloon launches for measuring vertical ozone profiles. The observatory also plays a critical role in tracking surface ozone and the effects of atmospheric pollutants. This visit reinforced the relevance of atmospheric monitoring for global climate and environmental protection.

The SatMet Division showcased advancements in the reception and processing of satellite data for weather forecasting. Students gained insights into the integration of satellite imagery with ground-based observations to enhance short-term and long-term forecasts. The division's staff explained the process of handling data from Indian satellites like INSAT and how this data feeds into daily and extreme weather event predictions. Students could relate this exposure to practical applications in AI, particularly in the fields of image processing and predictive modeling for climate analytics. Radar Division The final station was the

Radar Division, dedicated to weather surveillance through Doppler Weather Radars (DWR). Students witnessed demonstrations of how radars are used for detecting and tracking severe weather phenomena—such as cyclonic storms, thunderstorms, and rainfall intensity—across vast areas. The staff highlighted the advantages of Doppler radars, including their improved accuracy in warning systems and use in aviation safety, disaster management, and now casting. The division also discussed the technological advancements in radar networking and its role in supporting AI-based predictive weather models.

The visit to the Indian Meteorological Department offered an enriching experience, bridging textbook knowledge with practical, real-world applications for students of both Geography and AI. It emphasized the synergy between physical sciences and AI, preparing students to think critically about the technical and societal challenges in weather forecasting, disaster preparedness, and climate science.

EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO THE NATIONAL ART MUSEUM 6 AUGUST 2025

On 6 August 2025, the students of Class 11 & 12 visited the National Museum for an educational trip. The purpose of the visit was to help students learn about the history and development of Art in India. The museum is known for its collection of Indian Artist paintings, oil paintings, installation, sculpture etc. which the students found very interesting.

The visit started with a subject teacher where the students were shown different exhibits, including Indian old history artwork and sculptures. The students enjoyed the interactive displays and the indoor exhibits, where they could see the historical sculptures, artwork closely.

Through this visit, the students learned about Indus valley civilization & miniature painting. They discovered the important role of Indus valley civilization in our society. The trip also helped them understand the technique of miniature paintings in a creative way





At the end of the visit, the students had a discussion where they shared what they learned and how they felt about the experience. The visit to the National Museum was fun and educational, leaving a lasting impression on the students.

VISIT TO MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT OF SHIV NADAR UNIVERSITY 8 AUGUST 2025

“Pure mathematics is, in its way, the poetry of logical ideas.” – Albert Einstein

On 8 August 2025, a group of 28 students of Class XI, accompanied by three teachers, visited the Mathematics Department of Shiv Nadar University. The purpose of the visit was to provide students with exposure to advanced mathematical concepts, practical applications, and diverse career opportunities in the subject.



The second session, conducted by Dr. Azhar, focused on career opportunities in mathematics. He began by explaining how mathematics is not confined to academic classrooms but is a fundamental skill applied in almost every industry. He discussed exciting professions such as Data Scientist, who works with big data and predictive models; Actuary, who evaluates risk in insurance and finance; Mathematics Professor, contributing to teaching and research; Business Analyst and Data Analyst, who use quantitative techniques for decision-making; and Risk Analyst, who helps organizations assess and mitigate potential threats. Dr. Azhar also explained the difference between working in the private sector (where innovation, analytics, and technology dominate) and the government sector (which offers roles in research organizations, defense, statistical departments, and policymaking bodies). His talk gave students a clear picture of how strong mathematical skills can lead to rewarding and impactful careers.

In the third session, Dr. Parul Gupta explained the mathematics behind 2D and 3D rotation using matrices, complex numbers, and vectors. She demonstrated these concepts using GeoGebra software, making the session interactive and visually engaging.

The fourth session, led by Dr. Neha, introduced students to the fascinating world of Graph Theory. She began by explaining the basic terminology of graphs—vertices, edges, degree of a vertex—and then introduced the famous Königsberg Bridge Problem, a historical puzzle that led to the birth of graph theory. Using visual illustrations, she explained the concept of traversable graphs, where one can cross each edge exactly once, and highlighted the conditions for their existence based on the number of odd and even vertices in a graph. She guided students through examples, encouraged them to solve small graph problems on the spot, and related the concepts to real-life applications in network design, route planning, and computer science. This interactive approach kept students highly engaged, and many expressed curiosity to explore the topic further.

Towards the end of the visit, students explored the Mathematics Labs and the Mathematics Department Library, where they got a closer look at resources used for research and higher learning. The program concluded with a Mathematics Poster Fair presented by the department's Ph.D. students, showcasing their research work in various fields of mathematics.

Overall, the visit was an enriching, inspiring, and memorable experience. It broadened the students' horizons, deepened their appreciation for mathematics, and motivated them to explore the subject beyond their school curriculum.

SESSION BY SIR PAUL NURSE ON 'CONTROL OF CELL CYCLE' 26 MAY 2025

Two students of biology from grade XII along with Ms. Sonia Saraswat, PGT Biology from DPS R N Extension attended a session on 'Control of Cell Cycle' at **Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology Delhi** on 26 May 2025. The session was conducted by Nobel Laureate Sir Paul Nurse, the first director and chief executive of the Francis Crick Institute. He was awarded the 2001 Nobel Prize in Physiology



or Medicine for the discoveries of protein molecules that control the division of cells in the cell cycle. Dr. Paul explained role of cdk and cdc genes in regulating the different phases in cell cycle of yeast. He shared his research findings, including valuable personal experiences gained during the research process with students and urged them to appreciate the importance of thinking differently and being sceptical, especially of their own ideas and opinions. It was truly an inspiring session with one of science's greatest minds.

NATIONAL PHYSICAL LABORATORY (NPL), NEW DELHI INTERNSHIP DURATION: 3-13 JUNE 2025

Ramya Singh, Class-XI successfully completed her internship at the National Physical Laboratory (NPL), New Delhi, under the guidance of Dr. N. Vijayan in the Crystal Growth Division of the Department of Materials Science.

She worked on the synthesis and study of optical crystals, primarily:

- KHP (Potassium Hydrogen Phthalate)

She was also introduced to ADP and KADP crystals.

Ramya gained hands-on experience in crystal synthesis and growth techniques. Developed understanding of optical and nonlinear optical materials. Acquired practical lab skills and exposure to scientific research methods. Enhanced her knowledge in material science with applications in optics.

DECODING CUET: WHAT, WHY AND HOW? 12 JULY 2025

An offline session titled "Decoding CUET: What, Why and How?" was conducted in the Auditorium, Tagore Block for teachers of Grades VI to XII. The session was led by the Senior Academic Coordinator, Ms. Pooja Kohati and PGT Computer Science, Ms. Vidhi Hasija who provided a comprehensive overview of the Common University Entrance Test (CUET). CUET, conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), serves as a standardized entrance examination for admission to undergraduate programs in central and participating universities across India. The session highlighted key updates in CUET 2025, such as the option to select up to five subjects (including language and general test), a fixed 60-minute duration per paper, compulsory attempt of all 50 questions, and the shift to a completely computer-based mode.



The session also focused on practical tips and best practices related to the CUET form-filling process. Teachers were guided on helping students prepare essential documents in advance, ensuring correct file formats, and understanding ID requirements. The importance of checking specific subject eligibility criteria for each university was emphasized, along with strategies to avoid negative marking and manage multiple test slots effectively.

Teachers were encouraged to assist students in navigating credible websites for information, creating subject-university alignment charts, and building early readiness through consistent mentoring.

A heartfelt thanks goes to our Principal Ma'am for arranging such a mindful and timely session on a topic that is very much on the minds of our students, yet often surrounded by a cloud of uncertainty. ICSI CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM, EXPLORING COMPANY SECRETARY AS A CAREER **14 JULY 2025**

CS Vishal Gupta provided a clear and structured understanding of CS as a career, detailing the course pathway and its relevance in today's corporate setup. CS Shashank addressed the wide range of career opportunities, especially in law and corporate governance, and emphasized that every student has a unique acumen and skill set, which should guide their career choices. CS Shivam Sharma spoke in-depth about the international scope of the CS profession explaining how, with the right specialisations and certifications, Indian CS professionals can explore roles in countries like the UK, Canada, Singapore, and the Middle East, particularly in multinational companies and cross-border compliance roles.

They emphasized that a CS is not a secretary in the traditional sense. Instead, they ensure legal compliance, manage company law matters, and play a strategic role in board-level decisions, especially in listed companies and MNCs.

They also cleared several common misconception like pursuing CS alongside graduation (B.Com is a popular option), CS has strong demand in both the corporate world and government sectors. It is suitability for students with interest in law, logic, structure, and communication, rather than just finance

The session helped students discover a career that is structured, prestigious, and deeply relevant especially for those inclined towards law, management, and strategic leadership rather than purely financial fields. It was a rare opportunity to learn directly from professionals and understand that every student's path can be different.

AWARENESS/CAREER SESSION IN NEET AND IIT 14 JULY 2025

An informative and engaging awareness session on career opportunities in the medical (NEET) and engineering (IIT) fields was conducted for the students of Classes XI and XII (Science stream). JAGRITI: TOGETHER AGAINST SUBSTANCE ABUSE 6 OCTOBER 2025

A workshop on Substance Abuse Awareness was conducted at DPS R.N. Extension on 6 October 2025 for the students with the objective of sensitizing them about the dangers of substance abuse and the importance of making healthy life choices. In continuation with the Jagriti workshops against substance abuse, the initial session was for parents whereas the subsequent, current session was held for students. The session was led by Mr. Joshua Solomon, Head of the Counselling Cell and Ms. Riya Seth, Senior Counselor.



Mr. Joshua Solomon began the session by explaining what substance abuse actually is and how it can impact the physical, psychological, and social well-being of students. A career guidance session titled "The Science Spectrum: Careers Beyond JEE and NEET" was conducted on 31 October 2025 at DPS RN Extension for the students of Grades XI and XII (Science Stream). The session began with a formal yet engaging introduction by Ms. Pooja Kohati, who initiated a thought-provoking conversation about the societal expectations from students pursuing PCM/PCB, often limited to JEE or NEET. The session was then facilitated by Mr. Binit Binod, an eminent career expert from the Pratham Institute, who guided students through diverse and emerging career possibilities in the field of Science. The session aimed to broaden students' understanding of the diverse career avenues available to science learners beyond the conventional paths of JEE and NEET. Mr. Binod began by introducing various national-level entrance examinations that students can pursue after Grade XII. He also shared the important dates and details of these exams, emphasizing the need for timely preparation and awareness. He also emphasised the significance of board examinations, explaining how a strong performance can give students an upper edge during admissions and scholarship opportunities across reputed institutions.



Further, Mr. Binod elaborated on the opportunities available in research and scientific institutions, such as CSIR, and discussed specialised programs offered for both PCB and PCM students. He connected real-life scenarios to introduce the field of Forensic Science, helping students relate their learning to practical applications

He also discussed promising fields such as Food Technology, Agriculture, and Allied Sciences, introducing the scope of ICAR (Indian Council of Agricultural Research) and its affiliated courses. For students with an inclination toward Mathematics, Data Science, and Computer Science, he spoke about the prestigious Indian Statistical Institutes (ISI) and its esteemed programs. The session concluded with Mr. Binod presenting examples of successful leaders from companies like Uber, Ola, Flipkart, JP Group, and ICI, many of whom are alumni of IITs and NITs. These examples inspired students to dream big and explore multiple pathways within science-based careers.

Overall, the session was insightful, motivational, and eye-opening, providing students with a fresh perspective on career planning and encouraging them to explore the wide spectrum of opportunities beyond JEE and NEET.

For example, they explored how the kanji for “adult” (大人 – ōtona) is formed from the characters for “big” (大) and “person” (人) and how the word “volcano” (火山 – kazan) originates from the characters for “fire” (火) and “mountain” (山). This activity helped them appreciate the cultural and linguistic significance behind each character.

An effort to deepen the understanding between parents and their children, DPS R.N. Extension recently organized a one-of-a-kind interactive workshop titled *"Decoding Behavior: What Is My Child Really Saying?"* Designed exclusively for parents, the session aimed to cultivate greater self-awareness, offer practical behavior management techniques, and explore the emotional roots behind children's actions. This unique initiative recognized that children often communicate through behavior rather than words, and that understanding these signals can transform the parent-child dynamic.



The workshop opened with an exploration of common parenting challenges, encouraging parents to reflect on their own emotional patterns and responses. Through a series of interactive activities, and scenario discussions, parents were invited to step into their children's shoes and decode what lies beneath common behaviors such as tantrums, withdrawal, defiance, or emotional outbursts. A key focus of the session was the understanding that every behavior is a form of communication—often expressing needs like connection, safety, or autonomy.

Alongside this, the facilitators also addressed how parents' own childhood experiences, stress levels, and emotional states play a crucial role in how they respond to their child's behavior. By fostering self-awareness, the workshop empowered parents to break reactive cycles and respond more mindfully.

Parents were particularly receptive to the segment on building emotional safety at home, where practical tools were shared to create a trusting and open environment. Many participants expressed how the session shifted their perspective—helping them move from a reactive mindset to a more empathetic and connected approach. They appreciated the non-judgmental space and the focus on real, relatable challenges, calling the session insightful, practical, and emotionally grounding.

DECODING DYSLLEXIA AND DYSCALCULIA 3 MAY 2025

Each child is unique, with varying learning abilities. RPwD Act, 2016 focus areas are on the “difficulties” and giving warning signs for reading, writing, comprehension, Mathematics and Perception. The workshop aimed at the identification of the problem of dyslexia and dyscalculia at an early stage by the teacher and best support that can be given to the SLD (Special Learning Disabilities) children.



Mr. Joshua started the session by briefing about various Specific Learning Disabilities and shared valuable facts about them and discussed at length about the neurological disability of the SLD students. Thereafter, Ms. Kakoli touched upon the signs of dyslexia and their identification by the teacher viz. difficulty in segmenting words, omitting letters, slow reading, poor spelling skills, reversibility and directionality sp. For words like; p, b, q and d.

It was further discussed that the Classroom layout for the dyslexic child must use multisensory resources or methods. The teachers has to be empathetic and nurture innate talents by supporting them. Few simple strategies were also discussed like teaching rule of language, vowel teams , phonetics etc. In Hindi Barah Khadi ka khel as a game can enhance comprehension. Manipulatives like beads, blocks, sand etc, along with technology can support the child with SLD children.

Ms. Sadhvi while discussing on dyscalculia gave various useful ideas to scaffold students which will enhance their confidence and will make them feel accepted in the classroom. After the workshop, participants asked about their challenges which they faced during their teaching learning practices and Mr. Joshua gave satisfying answers to enthusiastic participants. The session concluded with Principal, Mrs. Pallavi Upadhyaya emphasizing on inclusiveness in the classroom and positive reinforcement to encourage the students with SLD to focus upon the progress not perfection.
